

## Consent form for COVID-19 antigen self-testing during the 2022/23 school year

Self-testing for COVID-19 using an antigen test requires the consent of the person to be tested or – in the case of school children under the age of 14 – of the parent or legal guardian. This consent applies to self-testing at school using an antigen test during the 2022/23 school year.
