GROUP 4: Biology; Chemistry; Physics; Sports, Exercise and Health Science: Minimum 1 course sl or 1 course hl

1 course in hl is to be selected. "SL" means 4h more (+2+2), "HL" 7h more (+4+3), **in total 11h.**

+Student autonomy focus (=IB courses/WPFs) in the form of overbooking:

Each student must select **another IB course** (either foreign language, group 2; social science (including Psychology), group 3; or natural science, group 4; or an art, group 6 (Visual Arts or Music).
